



Are you a “GOOD” Person?

- The Bible tells us, “Most men will proclaim every one his own goodness: but a faithful man who can find?” Proverbs 20:6
- Jesus said, “...there is none good but one, that is, God...” Mark 10: 18
- You may say, “I’ll make heaven my way.” The Bible says, “There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.” Proverbs 16:25
- Look at some of the Ten Commandments, God’s moral Law.
- 9) “Thou shalt not bear false witness [lie] against thy neighbour.” Exodus 20:16
- Have you ever told a lie to someone?
- 8) “Thou shalt not steal.” Exodus 20:15
- Have you ever stolen anything from someone—even something small?
- 7) “Thou shalt not commit adultery.” Exodus 20:14
- Jesus said “...whoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.” Matthew 5:28
- Have you ever committed adultery or looked with lustful thoughts at someone?

- 6) “Thou shalt not kill.” Exodus 20:13
- Jesus said “...That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment...” Matthew 5:22
- Also, “Whoever hateth his brother is a murderer...” 1 John 3:15
- Have you ever murdered, hated, or been wrongfully angry with someone? They are the same awful crime in God’s eyes.
- 1) “Thou shalt have no other gods before me.” Exodus 20:3
- (False gods: money, power, pleasure, self, etc.)
- Have you always worshipped, loved, and obeyed God above all else? Jesus called this the “first and great commandment.” Matthew 22:38
- God said, “...sin is the transgression [breaking] of the law.” 1 John 3:4
- You have broken God’s Law. Will you admit to breaking these commandments? If so, in God’s eyes, that makes you a liar, a thief, an adulterer, a murderer, and an idolater, does it not?
- “...There is none righteous, no, not one...For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.” Romans 3:10,23
- God sees it all. Every evil thing you have ever done, thought, or said is known to Him.

And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory... Then said I, Woe is me! For I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.

(place of punishment for lost sinners)

“And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.” Revelation 20:14,15 “...there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.” Matthew 13:50

“[Hell] Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.” Mark 9:44
“And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night.” Revelation 14:11 | ▼ 4

• *Friend, does all this concern you? You can escape the fiery torment of hell. There is hope for you!*

“Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ.” Titus 2:13

The Son of God - Jesus Christ - The Saviour

• Who is Jesus Christ? Let’s take a look.

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God... And the Word [Jesus] was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.” John 1:1,14

• God became a man: the man Christ Jesus was born of a virgin, and lived a sinless life.

Jesus said, “I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.” Revelation 1:8

“For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.” Luke 2:11

“For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given... and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.” Isaiah 9:6

“...the Father sent the Son [Jesus Christ] to be the Saviour of the world.” 1 John 4:14

“For he hath made him [Jesus Christ] to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.” 2 Corinthians 5:21

• Jesus died in your place for your sins, and received the punishment you deserve, so you could escape the horrible place of Hell.

“But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.” Isaiah 53:5,6

• God does not desire to send you to Hell.

“The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish [in Hell], but that all should come to repentance.” 2 Peter 3:9

Jesus said, “...repent ye, and believe the gospel.” Mark 1:15

The Gospel is that “...Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures.” 1 Corinthians 15:3,4 | ▼ 6

• God loves you and sent his son, Jesus Christ, to shed his sinless blood and die on the cross for your sins. He did this to give you eternal life, the forgiveness of all sins past, present, and future, and to deliver you from the penalty of your sins.

“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” John 3:16

“[Jesus] In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace.” Ephesians 1:7

“...Unto him [Jesus] that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood... to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.” Revelation 1:5

• Only Jesus Christ has the power to save your soul from Hell. Only Jesus Christ can wash your sins away and give you everlasting life.

“And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.” Matthew 28:18

“Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.” John 14:6

• God, with tender mercy, desires to save you from the Hell you deserve, and to give you the gift of eternal life. You cannot earn it, be good enough for it, go to church to merit it, or be water-baptized to receive it. *Jesus paid it all.*

“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.” Ephesians 2:8,9

“...but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” Romans 6:23b

“Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us...” Titus 3:5

• Do you desire to be saved from sin and Hell? “God ... commandeth all men every where to repent.” Acts 17:30

• Repent! God is holy. Your sins are condemning you to Hell. In your heart, turn from sin, and turn to Jesus Christ. Call upon the Saviour while you may. Plead for God to be merciful to you. Trust Jesus Christ alone.

“...for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.” 1 Peter 5:5
“...Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved...” Acts 16:31

“For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.” Romans 10:13 | ▼ 8

• Remember this:

“He that believeth on the Son [Jesus] hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.” John 3:36

“He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.” 1 John 5:12

“Seek the LORD, and ye shall live...” Amos 5:6

We encourage you to trust Jesus Christ as your Saviour. Prayerfully call on Him. He will hear you and not turn you away.

If you receive Christ as your Saviour. God promises “...I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.” Hebrews 13:5
